Changes to Processing Post Delivery Amendments

Customs and Border Protection is focused on refining ongoing approaches to managing our border risks. Our approach to managing Import Declarations that are amended after the goods have been delivered will be focused and specifically designed to manage and address this risk.

From 1 December 2011, Customs and Border Protection will no longer request Industry to produce supporting commercial documentation for every Post Delivery Amendment. Customs and Border Protection will advise Industry through existing ICS messaging, when it is deemed necessary to produce supporting commercial documentation.

While Customs and Border Protection facilitates the movement and clearance of cargo, Industry has an obligation to report any changes relating to any consignments. This will not change. Penalties exist where false information is reported to Customs and Border Protection.
