



## **Australian Customs Cargo Advice**

### **Reminder of Industry obligations in relation to Idle and Revoked Export Declaration Numbers (EDN) and Consolidated Reference Numbers (CRN) and Unfinalised Import Declarations**

#### **Idle and Revoked EDNs and CRNs**

EDNs and CRNs are required to be attached to a sub-manifest or main manifest within 10 days of the intended date of export.

An EDN or CRN lodged in the ICS (including those lodged via the AQIS system EXDOC) will change to a status of "idle" 10 days after the intended date of export if it has not been attached to a sub-manifest or a main manifest. After a further 20 days the EDN or CRN is revoked and cannot be subsequently amended.

Previously Customs and Border Protection staff have assisted industry through reminders via phone and email. These reminders will cease from 16 December 2011. ICS messaging will remain in place.

#### **Unfinalised Import Declarations**

Import Declarations are required to be paid prior to the delivery of cargo or withdrawn if entered in error. Import declarations that are amended post delivery are required to be paid at the time of amendment.

Industry can view their unfinalised declarations in the ICS. Previously Customs and Border Protection staff have assisted industry through reminders via phone and email. These reminders will cease from 16 December 2011. ICS messaging and reports will remain in place.
